Greenville County.KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, C. E. Norman,

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

at and before the sealing of these presents by P. E. Collins, Street Burns and Claud Neely, Trustees of Hampton Avenue Baptist Church,

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

P. E. Collins, Street Burns and Claud Neely, Trustees of Hampton Avenue Baptist Church, their successors and assigns;

"All these two (2) lots and pieces of land located just outside of the City Limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on LaBruce Street, and more specifically described as follows:

"Commencing at the N-W corner of LaBruce Street and Hampton Avenue, as shown on Plat hereinafter referred to, and running thence with said Hampton Avenue, N. $35^{\circ} 40'$ W. 110.17 feet to an iron pin corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 25; thence N. $57^{\circ} 35'$ E. 106 feet to an iron pin corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence S. $32^{\circ} 30'$ E. along the line of Lot No. 19, 110 feet to LaBruce Street; thence along said LaBruce Street, S. $57^{\circ} 35'$ W. 100 feet to the beginning corner. Being Lots Nos. 17 and 18, as shown on a Plat of the property of Henry Briggs, made March, 1923, by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, to which Plat reference is hereby made for a complete and adequate description of said lots."

Said Trustees are to hold said property in trust for the Hampton Avenue Baptist Church with no authority to sell or mortgage without a majority vote of the congregation of said Church, after the membership has had due notice of the conference.
