Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of the Augusta Road 340.8 ft. from the intersection of the Augusta and White Horse Roads and running thence along the Augusta Road N. 0.50 W. 160 ft. to an iron pin; thence along joint line of Piedmont Corporation and O. L.
