TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

Dickerson and (Mrs.) Maud Crowder Dickerson, his wife, all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said state and County, about half a mile bouth of the City of Greenville, including portions of two lots known and designated as Lots Numbered forty (40) and forty-one (41) of South Cherokee Park, as shown on the plat recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said county in Plat Book "A", at page 150, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the west side of Conestee Avenue, on the northeast corner of the twenty-foot strip conveyed by me to R. A. and L. M. Van Vechten by deed dated April 29, 1941, and recorded in said office in Book 231, at page 388, and running trance with line of said strip N. 63 W. about 173 3/4 feet, more or less, to a stake on an alley; thence with said alloy N. 27 E. seventy (70) feet to a stake; thence S. 63 E. about 173% feet, more or less, to a stake on Conestee Avenue (which stake is seventy feet southward from the southeast corner of the twenty-foot strip conveyed by me to L.
