on or about the 29th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-one exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Joseph E. Davis and Sarah Elizabeth Davis,

relief as to the real estate in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 23rd day of May, 1941, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be conveyed by H. Now, Therefore, Know, all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$800.00 Have Granted, conveyed and released, and by these presents, Do Grant, convey and release

to the said Lewis Belcher

the sum of Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars,
NOW KNOWN TO ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, H. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, do hereby certify that the sum of Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars

has been paid to me by the said Lewis Belcher

"All of that parcel or tract of land containing Nineteen and 50/100 (19.50) acres, more or less, lying on the East side of the Gap Creek Road, in Highland Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, having the following courses and distances:

Beginning in the center of the Gap Creek Road; iron pin on bank of road, on the W. M. Budduth line and runs thence N. 81 E. 2.30 chains to a stake in the branch; thence down the branch S. 2 E. 1.70 chains to a point in the branch; thence S. 41 W. 1.85 chains to a point; thence S. 1/2 W. 2.60 chains to the center of the Wildcat Creek; thence N. 58 E. 1.35 chains to a point in the mount of another branch; thence up the branch as a line S. 11 1/2 E. 3.85 chains, S. 11 E. 2.70 chains, S. 5 E. 2.20 chains, S. 19 W. 3.35 chains, S. 6 E. 3.30 chains, S. 24 E. 2.00 chains, S. 42 E. 3.85 chains, S. 32 E. 3.55 chains to a black gum, S. 28 E. 1.00 chains, S. 8 E. 2.70 chains, thence S. 18 W. 2.60 chains to a stone; thence S. 8 W. 7.66 chains to a stone; thence S. 7 1/2 W. 6.98 chains to a point in the center of the Gap Creek Road; thence with the road N. 2 E. 14.69 chains to a point; thence N. 1/2 E. 21.61 chains to a point in said road; thence N. 23 1/2 W. 3.22 chains to a point on the bridge on the Wildcat Creek; thence N. 28 1/2 W. 5.86 chains to a point, beginning corner."
