known and designated as Lots Nos. 43 and 44 as shown on a plat of the T. W. Dill Estate made by S. C. Moon, Surveyor, October, 1940, said plat recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County and State, said lots fronting 50 feet each on the east side of the Suber road a short distance south of the Super Highway about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer, said lots being each 50 feet on the rear, and each running back in parallel lines to a depth of 217 feet.
