James Edward Kellett.(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Edward Kellett, his heirs and assigns forever.All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview & Dials, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

about four miles from Fountain Inn, S. C., being a portion of the land conveyed by T. P. Cothran to J. M. Lancaster and J. H. Lancaster on March 22, 1919, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, Book 45, at page 208 with the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone corner of H. F. Knight and running N. $51\frac{1}{2}$ W. 20.00 to a stone; thence 79 W. 5.70 to stone in road; thence with road N. $19\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.50 to stone; thence S. 36 E. 4.04 to stone; thence N. $51\frac{1}{2}$ E. 18.50 to stone; thence S. 55 E. 23.40, crossing the Laurens County line to stone on branch; thence down branch to corner in branch, formerly Weisner line; thence S. $66\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.00 to stone on bank of another branch, corner of Henry F.
