City of Greenville, South Carolina

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land in the City of Greenville, South Carolina being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on McDaniel Avenue northeastern intersection of McDaniel Avenue and Newman Street according to a plat of McDaniel Heights made by Dalton & Neves, April 1941 and running thence 174.1 feet to an iron pin in the corner of lot number 59; thence in a southern direction across Newman Street and in line with McDaniel Avenue to the line of Mrs. Alden Simpson's property; thence in a western direction along the line of Mrs. Alden Simpson's property to McDaniel Avenue; thence in a northern direction along McDaniel Avenue to the point of beginning.

Also all that other piece, parcel and tract of land in the City of Greenville, South Carolina being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southeastern intersection of Belmont Avenue and Newman Street according to the above referred to plat and running thence S. 12-10 W. along the Western line of lot number 58 and continuing in a straight line to the northeastern intersection of Belmont Avenue and Cleveland Streets; thence crossing Belmont Avenue along the northern line of Cleveland Street to the northwestern intersection of Cleveland Street and Belmont Avenue which said intersection is the corner of the Ellis Johnson lot; thence in a straight line to an iron pin at the southwestern intersection of Belmont Avenue and Newman Street; thence crossing Belmont Avenue to the point of beginning.
