at and before the sealing of these presents by Irene Freeman Mayfield

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Irene Freeman Mayfield, her heirs and assigns:

~~All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in \_\_\_\_\_~~ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All of that tract of land situate in Cleveland Township, in the County and State aforesaid, containing approximately 20 acres, more or less, and is all of that tract of land hereinbelow referred to, lying west of the Greenville & Northern Railway Companies, right-of-way, except 1.66 acres of land which now belongs to said railway, the tract of land above referred to is all of that tract of land described by metes and bounds, contained in deed recorded in Deed Book 50, page 245, The portion of the above last named tract which is hereby conveyed begins at the west line of the right-of-way of said above named railway company and runs along said right-of-way and then embraces all of the remainder of the above tract, (except the 1.66 acres) above mentioned, lying on the west side of said railway.

Said land is a part of the same land that was conveyed to Stella P. Johnson and James H. Pritchett by E. Inman, master, by deed dated the 27th day of September, 1939, and recorded in Book 214, page 183, and was sold by Order of the court in the case entitled Stelle P. Johnson, plaintiff, against J. H. Cleveland, administrator, ect., et al, and formerly belonged to the estate of O. J. L. Pritchett.
