near Double Springs Baptist Church, adjoining lands of N. H. Mullinax on the North, W. S. Dill on the East and the new McAlhaney Road on the South and West, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from S. J. Collins Nov. 15, 1937, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 196 at page 317, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on a point in the center of the old McAlhaney Road, being the corner of W. S. Dill land and on the line of N. H. Mullinax, and runs thence with the Dill line, S. 3-30 E. 185 feet to a point in the center of the New McAlhaney Road; thence with the said new Road N. 71-30 W. 136 feet to bend; thence N. 77-30 W. 100 feet to bend; thence N. 82-20 W. 100 feet to bend; thence N. 86-30 W. 100 feet to point on N. H. Mullinax line in the intersection of the New and Old McAlhaney Roads; thence with the Mullinax line and with the center of the old McAlhaney Road N. 79-00 E. 100 feet to nail and stopper; thence N. 71-30 E. 200 feet to nail and stopper in center of old Road; thence N. 87-45 E. 128 feet to the beginning corner, and containing three fourths (3/4) of one acre, more or less.
