

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF VIRGINIA,
CITY OF RICHMOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that C. T. H. Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Virginia, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand, Seven Hundred Fifty (\$3,750.00) Dollars paid and secured to be paid by Claude H. Queen, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Claude H. Queen, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot #T-11 of North Hills, on plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H at page 116, said lot having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Bennett Street 50 feet from corner of Bennett Street and Russell Avenue and running thence along Bennett Street, S. 19-30 W. 51 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19-30 E. 51 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70-30 W. 150 feet to Bennett Street and the beginning corner, and being Tract No. 1 in deed from South Atlantic Investment Corporation to C. T. H. Corporation dated April 24, 1940, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 222, at page 362.

This deed is made subject, however, to the grantee herein assuming and agreeing to pay all taxes for the year 1941, and said conveyance is made subject to any restrictive covenants upon the above described property.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Claude H. Queen, his heirs or assigns forever.

And it hereby binds itself, its successors or assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Claude H. Queen, his heirs or assigns, against itself and its successors or assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

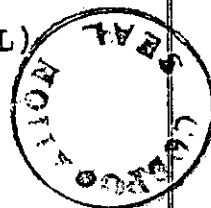

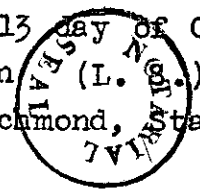
