to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto L. E. Black and Zaidie Black, their Heirs and Assigns, forever:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of Carolina Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 of Block F, Section No. 3, on plat of East Highlands Estates, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at page 36, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Carolina Avenue joint front corner of Lots No. 6 and 7 of Block F, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 6, N. 78-07 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the West side of a 5 foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with the West side of said strip S. 00-13 E. 70 feet to an iron pin on the North side of an unnamed street; thence with the North side of said unnamed street, S. 70-40 W. 170 feet to an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Carolina Avenue and said unnamed street; thence with the East side of Carolina Avenue N. 7-07 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the following building restrictions:

- (1) The lot herein conveyed shall be used for residential purposes only.
- (2) The lot herein conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes or persons of African descent.
- (3) No residence shall be erected on said lot costing less than \$2,250.00.
- (4) The building line as shown on the recorded plat and also other restrictions shown on said plat are to be strictly adhered to.

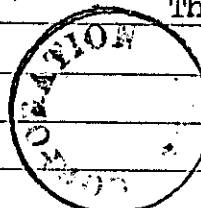
