(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. W. Lunsford, his Heirs and Assigns, forever:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northwest corner of the intersection of Cedar Lane Road and Worth Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, South Carolina and designated as Lot No. 1 on a plat of property of Knox L. Haynsworth, Trustee, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1941, which said Plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L at page 177, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Cedar Lane Road and Worth Street and running thence with the North side of Cedar Lane Road N. 58-30 W. 154.5 feet to an iron pin joint front corner of Lots No. 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 2 N. 34-0 E. 300 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 19; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 19 S. 58-30 E. 79.5 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Worth Street; thence with the West side of Worth Street S. 10-42 W. 172.6 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the West side of said Worth Street S. 29-57 W. 148 feet to the beginning corner.
