(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Caroline B. Moseley, her heirs and assigns forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots 45 and 46 on a revised plat of Sans Souci Highlands, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at page 173, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Sunshine Avenue, the joint front corner of lots 44 and 54, and running thence with the line of Lot 44, S. 58-17 E. 155.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-38 W. 87.5 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 46 and 47; thence with the line of lot 47 N. 66-40 W. 153.1 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Sunshine Avenue; thence with the Southeast side of Sunshine Avenue N. 22-30 E. 110 feet to the beginning corner.

These two lots above described are cut from and are a part of the tract of land conveyed to Mary G. Furman to H. J. Haynsworth by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 5, at page 215.

This deed is made pursuant to the powers conferred upon the grantor as Executrix under the last will and testament of H. J. Haynsworth, Deceased.
