It is the intention of the Deed to convey such parts, parcels or strips of our land that may be needed to convey a right-of-way of sections of the White Horse Rd. Ext. Road, having the width of 36 ft. Feet, that is 18 ft. Feet on each side of the center line, as staked out by the Engineer, except where there should be a cut or fill, may be necessary for extra width.

This right of way beginning at a point on the East side of the Augusta Rd. near the residence of Mr. Trayham and running through the entire Property of the Piedmont Corporation.
