(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Edwin J. Simpson and Zola T. Simpson, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
on the east side of Emma Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 17 of the property of
N. A. and Gladys G. Hack, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book L, at pages 132 and 133 (also shown on plat recorded in Plat Book L, pages 34
and 35), and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Emma Street at the joint corner of Lots
16 and 17, which point is just north of the Duke Power Company Power line, shown on said plat, and
running thence along the east side of Emma Street, N. 2-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner
of Lots 17 and 18; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 85-30 E. 300 feet to an iron pin;
thence S. 2-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lot No. 16; thence along the line of said
