WHEREAS, we the said surviving children desire to convey all rights, title and interest that we have or may have to certain lots of real estate, situated and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina:

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the said WILLIE LEE HENDERSON SMITH, Waneeta HENDERSON DAVENPORT, T. B. HENDERSON, J. L. HENDERSON, all of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, and R. B. HENDERSON, of the State of Maryland, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and love and affection, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said MINNIE D. HENDERSON, her heirs and assigns forever, all that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, and State of South Carolina, about one mile from the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in a subdivision of the Hammett Lands, known as "Oakwood", and known as Lot #31 as shown on the Plat of Oakwood, made by J. E. Sirrine, dated May 6, 1916, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on Cox Street, corner of Lot #30; and running thence 183! along the line of said Lot #30 to a 14! alley and thence along said alley 63! 4" to an iron pin, corner of Lot #32; thence 183! along said line of lot #32 to an iron pin on the corner of Cox Street; thence along Cox Street 63! 4" to the beginning corner.

AND ALSO

ALL that piece, parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville on Cox Street, and having the following boundaries:
