This is to advise that under the authority vested in me by the laws of this State, I have permanently closed the following roads:

Ready-Fork Road, J. D. Harris Road, Ashmore Bridge Road, Garrison Road, East Gantt Road, W. H. Willimon Road, Jenkins Road, Fork Shoals Road, Conestee Road and Grove Station Road, which formerly ran through the Greenville Army Air Base and any other roads that are within the area.
