I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Marie L. Woodall

on or about the 28th day of September in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-two exhibited her complaint in the Court of  
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Jacquelyn Woodall, and Jerry Woodall,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 13th  
day of October, 1942, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for  
the County aforesaid, to Henry J. Orr

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. X)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid  
decree, the sum of \$965.29

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Henry J. Orr

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, known and designated as Lot No. 21,  
recorded in Plat Book "G", at page 237, on the South side of Rogers Avenue, near the City of  
Greenville, in Greenville Township, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Rogers Avenue, corner of Lot No. 20,  
running thence with line of said lot S. 5-50 E. 150.5 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot  
No. 9; thence with rear lines of lots Nos. 9 and 8, S. 83-55 W. 50 feet to iron pin, corner of  
Lot No. 22; thence with line of said lot N. 5-50 W. 150.5 feet to the beginning iron pin on  
Rogers Ave.; thence with the southern side of Rogers Ave. N. 83-55 E. 50 feet to the beginning  
corner; said premises being that conveyed to Jason Woodall by Ida Heatherly by deed recorded  
in Book of Deeds 234, page 371."

The above property is conveyed subject to the mortgage of Citizens Lumber Company,
