All that piece, tract or lot of land lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County
and State aforesaid, on the south side and near a farm road leading from Town of Taylors by the
residence of Press Bennett, J. J. Bowlin and about two hundred yards south of the Southern
Railroad, being the lot on which the School House building stands, and lot No. 3 of Colored
School House lot divided by J. E. Freeman Sept. 15, 1927, and having the following metes and
bounds:

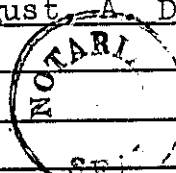
Beginning on iron pin on Press Bennett's line near southwest corner of old school house,
