CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

WHEREAS, H. H. Mathewson Buncombe Road, Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of Union Bleachery Athletic Association

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 24th day of October, A. D. 1942, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, That said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:
FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is Union Bleachery Athletic Association

THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is community of Union Bleachery, Greenville County, South Carolina

FOURTH. The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is To promote such educational, recreational, athletic, and general welfare activities and cooperative enterprises as may be determined to be for the best interest of the employees of Union Bleachery and the residents of Union Bleachery village, including, if so determined, maintaining, operating, and managing gymnasiums, playgrounds, athletic fields and teams, theaters, lectures and classes for instructions in health, hygiene, and other matters, and for entertainment, and generally to do any and everything necessary, expedient, or incidental to the operation of said activities.

Blackwell, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter ~~XXXV~~ ¹⁵⁸, Article ~~XX~~ ^{III} Code of ~~1932~~ ¹⁹³² and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter ~~XXXV~~ ¹⁵⁸, Article ~~XX~~ ^{III}, Code of ~~1932~~ ¹⁹³², and Acts amendatory thereto.
