C. A. Cooper and Lucille Cooper, their heirs and assigns:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 43 on plat of North Sunset Hills made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, July 1941 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book L at page 92 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive at joint front corner of Lots 42 and 43 and running thence with the line of Lot 42, N. 37-52 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest edge of a five-foot strip reserved for utilities; thence along the Northwest edge of said strip reserved for utilities, N. 43-22 E. 62 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 43 and 44; thence with the line of Lot 44, S. 37-27 E. 187 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive; thence with the Northwest side of Elizabeth Drive S. 54-48 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property that was conveyed to the grantor as Trustee by deed of Riverside Land Company dated July 9, 1941 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 234 at page 121, and this conveyance is made pursuant to the powers given me under said deed.

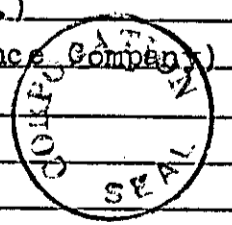

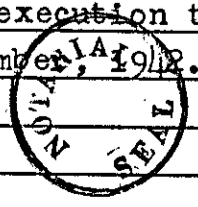
