lying on both sides of the Roper Mountain-Bennett's Bridge surface-treated road, bounded by lands of C. C. Thompson, H. E. Rector, J. B. Cox, et al, with metes and bounds to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of above-named road, corner of C. C. Thompson land, and of other lands this day being conveyed by me to John W. Bagwell and running thence N. 86-50 E. 567 feet to a point in the center of said road (iron pin on south bank of road), thence S. 0-30 W. 354 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89-30 W. 1,019 feet to an iron pin on the east bank of branch, thence S. 68-30 W. 466 feet to an iron pin on line of H. J. and Louisa Bagwell land; thence along Bagwell line S. 40-45 E. 423 feet to an iron pin J. B. Cox corner; thence along Cox line N. 42-24 E. 408 feet to an iron pin at branch; thence continuing along Cox lands S. 22 E. 312 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 49-30 E. 301.6 feet to a B. G. Stump near the branch; thence S. 47-10 E. 316 feet to iron pin across branch, thence S. 82-45 E. 859 feet to a point in the center of the Pelham surface-treated road, thence along said road N. 14-40 E. 629.5 feet to pin in the eastern edge of the surface-treated road, thence N. 74 W. 141.2 feet to an iron pin; thence due N. 105.6 feet to an iron pin in farm road, thence N. 81 E. 169.6 feet to an iron pin in the eastern edge of the surface treated road; thence, N. 46-35 E. 36.7 feet to an iron pin on eastern side of said road; thence N. 1-00 W. 742 feet to iron pin corner of C. C. Thompson's land; thence S. 79-15 W. 1,331 feet to the beginning corner, containing 40.50 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of survey made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, December 21, 1942 and being a part of two tracts of land as follows:- (1) A tract of land conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, for 52 3/4 acres, more or less, dated November 11, 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C.
