and being known and designated as Lot No. 14 in Block "D", of the Cagle Park property, as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to survey made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, April 13, 1926, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

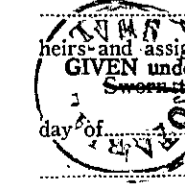
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER
