

GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Bennet A. Meyers, domiciled and residing in Greenville (Post, City or Town), State of South Carolina, and being desirous of appointing an attorney-in-fact to act for me on my behalf on all matters in which I may have an interest, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Frances S. Meyers, of Greenville (Post, City, or Town), County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with full power to sell, transfer, exchange or otherwise dispose of any of my property, real, personal or mixed and to execute and deliver good and sufficient deeds or other instruments for the conveyance or transfer of the same; to collect, sue, compromise or otherwise dispose of any claim or debt to which I now or hereafter may have an interest; to pay, compromise, or otherwise discharge and secure releases from any obligations or claims against me; to deposit in my name and for my account with any bank, banker, or trust company all moneys which may come to HIS/HER hands as such attorney and all bills of exchange, drafts, checks, promissory notes, and other securities for money payable or belonging to me, and for that purpose to sign my name and indorse the same for deposit or collection, and from time to time withdraw any or all moneys deposited with the aforesaid bank, banker or trust company or any other banking institution having moneys belonging to me, and for the purpose to draw checks in my name.

FURTHER, I do authorize my aforesaid attorney-in-fact to perform all necessary acts in the execution of the aforesaid authorizations and generally to do any and all acts on my behalf on any other matter or thing pertaining or belonging to me with the same validity as I could effect, if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said attorney shall and may do, by virtue hereof, in the premises

FURTHER, This power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until revoked by me.
