All of that certain piece, parcel or track of land situated, lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of Middle Tyger River and on the west side of the Gowansville road and containing 63.80 acres and being known as a part of track No. 3 of the Sub Division of the J. O. Owings Estate.


