All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the east side of Middle Tyger river and on the west side of Gowansville road, and containing  
63.80 acres, and being known as a part of tract No. 3 of the sub-division of the J. O. Wingo  
Estate, and being described more particularly as follows:

Beginning on the middle of the upper side of the cement bridge on the Gowansville  
road and running thence S. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 9.39 chains; thence S. 46 E. 3.98 chains; thence S. 62 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 3  
chains; thence S. 39 W. 1.75 chains; thence S. 8 E. 2 chains; thence S. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 3.87 chains to a  
small water oak in A. G. Fisher's line; thence to the river S. 62 W. 18.63 to a mulberry tree on  
bank of Middle Tyger river; thence up middle Tyger River to a birch tree, W. J. Lance's corner;  
thence N. 50-40 E. up ditch to forks of branch; thence N. 83 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 5.75 chains to head of ditch;  
thence S. 74 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 12.39 chains to stake on north side of branch; thence N. 76-25 E. 5.09 chains to  
center of upper rail of said cement bridge, the beginning corner. Less, however, 3.17 acres  
deeded by me to W. B. Lance by deed dated August 19, 1943, yet to be recorded, and taken from  
foregoing tract of land, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the road leading from Cockrell's bridge to Gowansville, and  
runs thence S. 32.25 E. 189 feet to a stake on west side of said road; thence S. 58.00 W. 265 feet;  
thence S. 10.30 E. 395 feet to a large water oak, old corner; thence N. 52.40 E. 255 feet; thence  
N. 8.10 E. 132 feet; thence N. 39-10 E. 116 feet; thence N. 2.40 E. 198 feet; thence N. 66-08  
W. 272 feet to the beginning corner. The foregoing land was conveyed to me by deed from S. B.  
Lance dated Nov. 4, 1933, and recorded in R.M.C. Office in Vol. 255, page 343.
