

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, } BY THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE.
EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, P. C. Fant and J. M. Perry
both of Greenville, S. C.,

did on the 24th day of August, 1943, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Starcross, Inc.,

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.,

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is manufacturing, finishing, converting, buying, selling and generally dealing in and with textile fabrics of all kinds, including natural and synthetic materials and fabrics, and to acquire, construct, establish, conduct and operate plants, mills, factories and warehouses as may be necessary or expedient in connection therewith; to buy, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge and deal in goods, wares and merchandise and real and personal property of every kind; and to do all things incident or necessary to any such business and in general to carry on any business not contrary to the laws of the State of South Carolina and to have and exercise all of the powers, rights and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of South Carolina in connection therewith.

Pursuant to law, the Capital Stock of the within Corporation has been this day increased to the sum of \$500,000.00 three hundred thousand and no/100ths Dollars. Given under my hand and the Seal of the State at Columbia, this 9th day of February, A. D. 1948.



FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Forty thousand Shares without par value

payable twenty (20%) per cent cash and balance at call of Directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is forty thousand (40,000) without par value.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 23rd day of August, 1943, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors:

P. C. Fant and J. M. Perry,

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President P. C. Fant as Vice-President, J. M. Perry; as Secretary, J. M. Perry as Treasurer, P. C. Fant

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

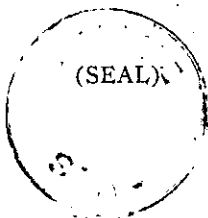
a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
