JUDGMENT

Civil Action No. 337

Tract No. 29

This day comes the petitioner in the above-entitled cause, the United States of America, by O. H. Doyle, United States Attorney for the Western District of South Carolina, through W. H. Arnold, Special Assistant, and move the Court to enter a judgment with respect to the tract of land hereinafter described.

It having been made to appear to the satisfaction of this Court,

(1) That heretofore on April 6, 1943, there was filed in this proceeding Declaration of Taking No. 3, amended Petition in Condemnation, and Judgment on said Declaration of Taking, whereby the United States of America acquired the fee simple interest in that tract of land hereinafter described.

(2) That there was deposited, simultaneously with the filing of the Declaration of Taking, the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) in the Registry of this Court as the estimated compensation for the taking of said tract of land.

(3) That the following is a correct description of the tract of land which is made the subject of this judgment:

All that certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as follows: A strip of land 60 feet wide and 230 feet long through other lands formerly of Sam Rosemond but now owned by Butler Rosemond, bounded on the east by tract formerly known as the Washington tract but later owned by Alister and Rudolph Brockman; on the north and south by other lands of Butler Rosemond; and on the west by property of Oscar Townes, being a part of the land described
