Beginning at a stone in the center of a road, joint corner of property of Cross and Flemming and running thence S. 2-15 W. 443 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 46-40 W. 707 feet; thence N. 77 E. 221 feet; thence S. 70 E. 121 feet; thence S. 76-30 E. 207 feet to the beginning corner, containing 3.6 acres, more or less, according to survey made by W. H. Riddle May 30, 1943.
