Beginning at a point in the White horse Rd. joint corner of lots No. 1 and 2 and running
thence along line of lot No. 1 N. 3-55 W. 555 feet to stake on line of lot No. 4; thence along
line No. 4 N. 86 W. 110 feet to corner lot No. 3; thence along line of lot No. 2 S. 1-50 E. 427.4
feet to a point in White Horse Rd. thence along Rd. S. 48-0 E. 180 feet to the beginning corner
