All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Woodruff Road, about 8 miles East of the City of Greenville, containing 70.26 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point in road on I. S. Burrell line; thence S. 50-40 E. 1453 feet to stake on branch; thence N. 37-43 E. 1194 feet to stone; thence N. 78 E. 553 feet to iron pin; thence N. 11-36 W. 1830 feet to iron pin on road; thence S. 61 W. 403 feet to post oak on West side of road; thence S. 28-30 W. 608 feet to a point on east side of road; thence along road S. 48 W. 1812 feet to beginning.
