containing sixty (60) acres, more or less, and beginning at a Chestnut oak, and runs thence in a northerly direction in line of William Massey's land; thence with the Massey Line to the Brissack land; thence along the Brissack line to the tract of one Balew - poplar corner; thence with the Balew Line to stone corner; thence with the Balew line to corner in bottoms; thence with the Balew line to stone on Mountain; thence with the line of the Estate of J. M. Moon to the beginning corner.

ALSO, that other tract of land adjoining the above tract, containing one hundred twenty-five (125) acres, and beginning at a stone on the J. M. Moon Estate line, and runs thence northerly with the said J. M. Moon Estate line to stone on side of Creek; thence northwest to a pine; thence north-east to a black-gum on J. A. Center's line; thence southeast to a stone; thence east to a stake; thence south with Will Center's line to a red oak on a branch; thence west to a stone at the lower end of the bottom at Morgan's Creek; thence south to a red oak; thence west with J. M. Moon Estate line to the beginning corner.

The above two tracts are the same conveyed to Annie E. Sloan by C. E. Sloan, and to him by deed of W. K. Golightly by deed recorded in Vol. 187, page 112; and this deed is intended to convey the undivided one-half interest therein conveyed to W. F. Campbell by deed of Annie E. Sloan, recorded in Vol. 203, page 318, which half interest to him was devised to the grantors herein by the will of the said W. F. Campbell.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantee is to pay off all taxes due on the said property.
