I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, South Carolina National Bank of Greenville, S. C., a Corporation

on or about the 22nd. day of June in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-seven exhibited its complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against William Morris

demanding judgement in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th
day of August, 19 27, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a _____ Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the
County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having

dispose of the same unto Mrs. Fannie C. Norwood

for the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars,
being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, now All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars,
to me paid by the said Mrs. Fannie C. Norwood

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the
said Mrs. Fannie C. Norwood

"All that certain lot of land situate in Greenville Township, State and County
aforesaid, City of Greenville, being Lot No. 49, of Washington Heights Subdivision, according
to a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr. February 3, 1922, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for
said County in Plat Book F, page 54, said lot fronting 35 feet on Burnett Avenue and having
a depth on its northern side of 130.8 feet and on its southern side of 127 feet."

(A deed was made in the above case on September 28, 1927, and is of record in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 140, page 252, and the deed that I am now
making is intended to be a duplicate of said deed and the purpose of making this present deed
is to correct certain errors which appear in the recorded deed above referred to.)
