in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said W. H. Willimon, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being known and designated as Lot No. 151 on a plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated December, 1943, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Main Street and running thence along the line of the land of W. H. Willimon N. 37 W. 208.5 feet to an iron pin; corner of land of W. H. Willimon; thence N. 49-0 E. 417 feet along the land of W. H. Willimon to an iron pin; thence N. 37 W. 432.9 feet to an iron pin on an unnamed street; thence along said unnamed street S. 20-24 W. 867.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-32 E. 226 feet to an iron pin on Main Street; thence along Main Street N. 56-20 E. 188.8 feet to the beginning corner.

The Grantors reserve to themselves, their heirs and assigns, and except from this conveyance all water pipe lines, valves, fittings, hydrants, poles, wire, transformers, all other fittings or other apparatus used in connection with and forming a part of the water and electric distribution system used at Conestee which may be located upon the lot herein conveyed. The Grantors further reserve to themselves, their heirs and assigns, the right and easement in perpetuity to go upon the land for the purpose of maintenance, operation and repair of the above mentioned pipe and electric transmission lines as the same are now located, to remove and relocate said lines or construct other lines so that the lines as so relocated or constructed will run in, under or above any part of said land and to operate and maintain the lines as so relocated or constructed.

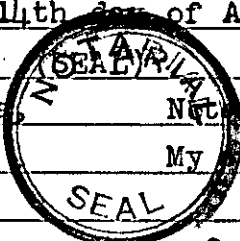
