at and before the sealing of these presents by Mollie Syracuse and Jamile Abraham (Jamile Howard),

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mollie Syracuse and Jamile Abraham (Jamile Howard), share and share alike; that is, to say each is to have a one-half interest in the land and personal property hereinafter conveyed -  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

situate on Dunbar Street in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 6 on plat recorded in Plat Book "A", at page 163, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake at corner of Lot No. 5 and running thence with line of said lot in a southern direction 215 feet to corner of Lot No. 7; thence with line of that lot in a north-eastern direction 215 feet to stake on Dunbar Street; thence with said Street, N. 76 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner."

ALSO:

All of my personal property of whatsoever kind and description secured by me from the estate of my husband, J. J. Jabo, sometimes known as John Jabbo, and in addition any personal property of any description which I may own myself in my own name.

I hereby reserve a life estate for myself in the real estate above described and likewise the personal property herein described but this deed is to be recorded now.

The above property is the same as conveyed to John Jabbo, who is one and the same person as J. J. Jabo, by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated February 15, 1926, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 110, page 230.
