(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Clifton I. Robinson, his Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Cedar Lane Road near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 7 on Plat of property of Knox L. Haynsworth, Trustee, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book "L" at Page 177, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North Side of Cedar Lane Road at joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7, said pin also being 654.5 feet West from the Northwest corner of the intersection of Cedar Lane Road and Worth Street and running thence with the line of Lot No. 6, N. 34-00 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 14, N. 58-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot No. 8, S. 34-00 W. 300 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Cedar Lane Road; thence with the North side of Cedar Lane Road, S. 58-30 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to Knox L. Haynsworth, Trustee, by deed of Riverside Land Company dated June 9, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 234, at page 121. The grantor herein was substituted as Trustee, as will appear by reference to the order of Hon. G. Dewey Oxner, Resident Judge, dated November 19, 1943, in Judgment Roll E-9758 in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, S.C., and this conveyance is made by the grantor as Trustee pursuant to the power and authority therein granted.

This property is conveyed subject to the following building restrictions:

(1) This lot is to be used for residential purposes only and no dwelling shall be erected thereon that shall cost less than \$2250.00 when completed, and no part of said dwelling shall be nearer the front line of said lot than 50 feet.

(2) This lot shall not be sold or leased to any person of negro blood.
