(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
W. K. Stacy, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the west side of Bennett Street near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, between Bennett Street and Westview Avenue, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11 of Section "A" of Parkvale, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "K", page 52 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Bennett Street, corner of Section "B" of Parkvale and running thence along Bennett Street S. 8-30 W. 140 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the line of Lot No. 7, N. 88-30 W. 182 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 7, 8, 11 and 12; thence along the line of Lot No. 12, N. 89-0 W. 164 feet to an iron pin on Westview Avenue; thence N. 12-0 E. along Westview Avenue 70 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence N. 4-0 E. along Westview Avenue 70 feet to an iron pin, corner of Section "B" of Parkvale; thence S. 89-0 E. 350 feet to the beginning corner.

This deed is made subject to the protective covenants or restrictions dated September 30, 1940, recorded November 8, 1940 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Volume 227, page 173, as fully as though said protective covenants or restrictions were fully set forth in this deed.
