All that piece, parcel or lot of land in x .....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain lot of land in the Town of Greer, in the County and State aforesaid, situated on the north side of Victoria Street, in block between Main and Trade Streets, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Victoria Street, and running thence with said Street, S. 79 W. 25 feet to a pin; thence N. 10.30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79 E. 25 feet to to corner; thence S. 10.30 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning on Victoria Street.

Also that certain lot of land in the Town of Greer, County and State aforesaid, situate on the north side of Victoria Street and lying immediately west of and adjoining the lot above described, and having the following lines, courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a pin on Victoria Street, which pin is the southwest corner of the lot above described and running thence with said Street, S. 79 W. 25 feet to a pin; thence N. 10.30 W. 100 feet to a pin on an alley; thence with said alley N. 79 E. 25 feet to corner of lot above described; thence with line of said S. 10.30 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning on Victoria Street.

The two lots above described being the same conveyed to O. M. Mitchell by E. Inman, Master and recorded October 19th 1921 in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, Book 59, page 192.

The above described property is the same devised to me conditionally by the will of O. M. Mitchell, filed in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Apartment 191 and File 28, and title in me became absolute upon the death of Pearl Plurer Mitchell intestate, without having disposed thereof during her lifetime.
