ARTICLES OF SEPARATION.

WHEREAS, Samuel Amedeo Foschini and Kathleen Durham Foschini, of Greenville, South Carolina, heretofore entered into a marriage contract on the 12th day of May, 1942, at Spartanburg, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, said parties on account of disputes and disagreements are now living separate and apart, and have mutually agreed that it is to their best interest to live separate and apart at all times in the future:

NOW, THEREFORE, this agreement made and entered into at Greenville, South Carolina, this 16th day of October, 1944 by and between Samuel Amedeo Foschini, hereinafter referred to as "husband", and Kathleen Durham Foschini, hereinafter referred to as "wife";

WITNESSETH:

1.

That the parties hereto shall live separate and apart at all times in the future, and each shall be free from interference, authority and control by the other as fully as if he and she were sole and unmarried, and each may conduct, carry on and engage in any employment, business or trade which to him or her shall seem advisable for his or her sole or separate use and benefit, without and free from any control, restraint or interference by the other party in all respects as if each were unmarried and no contract of marriage had ever been entered into between them.

II

That each party shall own and possess in his or her own name, without claim or interference by the other, all property heretofore owned, or which may be hereafter acquired by him or her in his or her own name.

III

The wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred Seventy-Five (\$1875.00) Dollars, cash, to her in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, agrees as follows:

(a) That said wife has and does by these presents forever release and discharge the said husband from any and all claims of support of every nature and kind, and does hereby renounce any and all claim by way of dower in any property which the said husband may now own, or hereafter acquire, and does further agree to execute any instruments or renunciations of dower upon presentation to her at any time in the future, in order to make this agreement legally effective in all respects, in accordance with the true intention of all the parties hereto.

(b) The said wife further agrees, as a part of the consideration of this agreement, that the husband shall have the right to obtain a divorce at any time hereinafter, and in the event he files a petition for said divorce she agrees to accept service of the bill of complaint, consent to a decree of divorce and fully cooperate in all respects so that a divorce may be obtained without contest on her part, provided the grounds for divorce cast no reflection upon said wife.

IV.

The parties further mutually agree, and each of them does hereby renounce and relinquish any and all claims which he or she might have in the estate of the other, in case of the death of such other, as heir or distributee, so that upon the death of either the husband or wife named herein, his or her estate shall be distributed in the same manner as though said husband and wife named herein had never been married.

V.

As a part of the consideration of the sum herein paid to the wife, the wife agrees that the actions now pending against the husband are hereby settled, withdrawn and forever ended.
