Smith; thence along the Smith line Eighty-four and 9/lo feet to the line of the lot of J. V. Croskeys, at an iron pin on said line Thirty-five and 3/lo feet from Emma Smith lot; thence along the line of J. V. Croskeys, to her neices, Henrietta Sydnor, Rebecca Sydnor, Jarriett Sydnor, Elizabeth Ford and Mattie Ford, and to her nephews, Deveaux Sydnor and G. Thomas Ford. The said G. Thomas Ford departed this life on 17th day of Dec. 1943, leaving of force his last Will and Testament under and by which he devised all his property to his wife, Mrs. Ella W. Ford. The Will of G. Thomas Ford is proved and filed in the office of the Judge of Probate for Georgetown County, State aforesaid, and a certified copy of the same is filed and recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate for Greenville County in Will Book "T" at page x.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W. O. Groce and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. O. Groce and his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
