(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto, the said
John Suttles, Henry Clark and Manly Mason, Trustees of the Wilson Graveyard, and their
successors in office forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick SpringsTownship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
about one half mile North from Greer, lying on the Western side of the Mosteller Road (State
Highway No. 14), being bounded on the North by lands of Mrs. Margaret Green (formerly Mrs.
Ellen W. Crain), on the East by the said Mosteller Road, on the South by other lands of myself,
and on the west by lands of the Wilson Graveyard, and being a part of the same land recently
conveyed to me by deed from E. B. (Buford) Crain, and having the following courses and distances,
to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin at the corner of a concrete monument, Wilson Graveyard corner and
corner of the Greene lot, and runs thence with the Graveyard lot line S. 24-25 E. 97 feet to a
stake, new corner on the Graveyard lot line; thence a new line N. 79-45 E. 100 feet to a point
in the center of the said Mosteller Road (iron pin back on line at 67 feet); thence with the
center of the said road as the line N. 31-13 W. 46.6 feet to a bend; thence N. 40-00 W. 90
feet to a nail and stopper in the center of the road (iron pin on western bank of road at
29.5 feet); thence with the Greene line S. 54-48 W. 66.2 feet to the beginning corner, and
containing Ninety Five Hundred square feet, more or less.
