All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the Town of Simpsonville, on the South side of South Pliney Circle, known and designated as Lot No. 41 of the subdivision known as League Estates according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, October, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 111-112, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
