And I further specifically appoint the said Frances McGill Dobson my true and lawful Attorney in Fact for me, and in my name and stead, to receive, recover and control any and all sums of money, securities, or title or deed or conveyances to real estate drawn to me by the Executors and Trustee of the Will of my father, R. D. Dobson, deceased, it being contemplated that certain items of such property shall be delivered to me upon my attaining the age of twenty-five years, and upon receiving the same she is fully empowered hereby to sign receipts or releases and to endorse checks or other instruments in carrying out the purposes herein authorized and to do these acts in my name and stead as completely as I might do if present.
