All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the north side of Monte Vista Avenue about a mile beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and known as Lot No. 18 on a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, March 5, 1923, recorded in R. M. C. Office in Plat Book F, page 108, of the lands of D. T. Smith, described as follows:
