to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Ethel C. Harling

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ethel C. Harling, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina about 11 miles South of the City of Greenville and about one mile East of the Augusta Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a point in center of a county road which leads from Reedy Fork Church to Moonville at corner of Robert T. Cox land and running thence along said road N. 77 W. 200 feet to a point in said road; thence S. 14-50 W. 300 feet to stake; thence S. 32.45 E. 354.7 feet to a stake on line of said Robert T. Cox land; thence with his line N. 31-30 E. 193 feet to an iron pin; thence still with his line N. 3-30 W. 378 feet to the beginning corner and containing 2.67 acres more or less and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed of T. M. Cox dated July 22, 1931 and recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Volume 220, page 321.

The only condition to this deed is that I shall retain possession and control of the property herein conveyed as long as I shall live and at the time of my decease, then the grantee shall have full possession and fee simple title.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ethel C. Harling, her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
