Vaughn, Known and designated as lot No. 2B in the N. A. and Gladys Back, subdivision as shown by a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book L, at page 188 and 189, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on a County Road, joint corner of Lots No. 2 and 2B, and runing thence with line of Lot No. 2 N. 6-20 W. 292.8 ft. to a point in line of lot No. 1A; thence with line of lot No. 1A S. 82-30 W. 60 ft. to joint corner of lot No.2B & 3; thence with line with lot No. 3 S. 6-20 E. 293 ft. to a point in said County Road; thence with said Road N. 82-45 E. 60 ft to the beginning corner.
