ADDENDUM TO LEASE

April 1, 1947 keep the present building and improvements situated on said premises insured with solvent and reliable insurance company or companies to the extent of seventy-five thousand dollars and in the event of the destruction or damage of said building and improvements apply the entire proceeds derived from said policy or policies of insurance, or so much as may be necessary, toward the repair and restoration of said building and improvements, said building to be restored as far as possible to its present condition. It is understood that this provision shall constitute a part of the original lease hereinabove referred to.
