Estes, my wife, for the term of her natural life if she then be living, then after my death and the death of my said wife, Kate E. Estes unto my four children Augustus L. Estes, Kate E. Connor, Louise E. Chastain and Anne E. Wood, the remainder in fee simple to them and their heirs and assigns forever.

FIRST: All that lot of land near the City of Greenville, on the Lowndes Hill Road, designated as Lot No. 2 in a subdivision of J. A. Floyd land, as shown on a plat thereof which is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "G", at page 132, and more particularly described as follows:

EEGINNING at a point on the south side of the said Lowndes Hill Road, at joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with said road S. 65-47 E. 80 feet to corner of Lot No. 3; thence with line of Lot No. 3, S. 15-35 W. 76.8 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence N. 75-54 W. 75 feet to joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence with line of Lot No. 1, N. 12-53 E. 90.6 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by E. This is a deed of gift reserving first a life estate to myself end then a life estate to my wife, Kate E. Ester, the remainder over to my four children herein named.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenences to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or apportaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned first reserving life estate to myself then a life estate to my wife, Kate E. Estes, then the remainder unto my said four children Augustus L. Estes, Kate E. Connor, Louise E. Chastain and Anne E. Wood, their heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Grantees, their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
