exchange real property; buy, own, manufacture and repair, sell, exchange personal property principally wood and metal products; loan money, receive and accept securities therefor, borrow money for corporate purposes, execute and deliver its obligations therefor, purchase accounts, notes, bills of exchange, collect, sell or otherwise dispose of the same, to receive as security pledges, notes, mortgages, and each and every other form of collateral therefor and do each and every act or acts incidental to or necessary to affectuate the corporate purpose, To donate to any legitimate enterprise (charitable) any lawfully permitted amount of the income from time to time.

as Vice-President, Fred M. Thompson; as Secretary, Fred M. Thompson

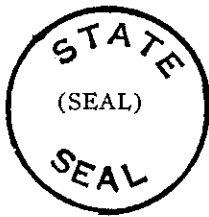
as Treasurer, Fred M. Thompson

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P.
