KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Mrs. Malinda Isadore Moore, Mrs. Rachael Jolly, Richard Williams, Sherman Williams, Norman Williams and James Williams

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and 00/100 (\$1500.00) DOLLARS

to us in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Charlie Cross

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Charlie Cross, his heirs and assigns forever,

All our right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Worley Road (erroneously called Chick Springs Road) sometime being a portion of Tract No. four (4) of the property of J. C. Hall as shown on plat of R. E. Dalton, C. E., made in December, 1916, and having the following metes and bounds, as shown on said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in Worley Road, and running thence S. 28-15 W. along line of lot of Arthur Nicholls one hundred and nine (109) feet to iron pin; thence S. 53-0 E. two hundred and forty-five (245) feet to stake; thence N. 6-30 E. one hundred and nine (109) feet to stone near Worley Road; thence N. 53-0 W. two hundred and ten (210) feet (touching the Worley Road) to beginning.
